HIPAA Compliance Deadline is Today, TrueVault is Here to Help

Those handling protected health information (PHI) are now governed by new rules

Newport Beach – September 23, 2013 – As of today, covered entities and business associates must be in compliance with the HIPAA Omnibus Rule. The final omnibus rule represents the most significant changes to the HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules since they were first implemented. Healthcare providers, healthcare clearinghouses, health plans, and their business associates need to be HIPAA compliant by September 23, 2013. This includes covered entities, anyone who provides treatment, payment and operations in healthcare, and business associates, anyone with access to patient information and provides support in treatment, payment or operations. Subcontractors, or business associates of business associates, must also be in compliance.
